The students of the college got a chance to interact with HR Manager,

Ms. Kanika & her team of engineers who brief them about the Chenab textile mill kathua which is one of the leading company in the textile industry and one of the largest single mill setup producing spun fibre-dyed yarns in Asia. They were also briefed that the mill specializes in producing blends of viscose staple fibre, polyester staple fibre, acrylic staple fibre, polyester staple fibre, acrylic staple fibre, in more than 120 ctons of yarn capacity of more than 120 tons of yarn

per day. The students were also explained about step by step preparation of the various yarns being manufactured by the mill.
