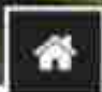






- 1) On March 3<sup>rd</sup> 2019 between 12:30 PM and 1:00 PM the chain of event that transpired that day were:
- Meena and Naresh neighbours of Neha (also colleagues of Neha) heard screams of a lady they rushed out and discovered that screams were coming out of Vivek's house.
  - To their surprise they found that Vivek and his parents were standing near kitchen and broken door was lying on the floor.
  - Neha was and engulfed in flames and the situation was very panic. Veena asked for a blanket and water from father-in-law of Neha.
  - Gopal koshan went inside and brought a blanket and Vivek rushed in bathroom for fetching a bucket of water.
  - Veena extinguished the fire with the help of blanket and water.
  - Neha turned her side and Veena inquired from her as to what happened, Neha said that her mother-in-law Pushpa had poured kerosene over her and her husband Vivek had set her on fire.
  - In the meanwhile Naresh went to call the doctor and ambulance and another member neighbour Ravi who also reached there after hearing screams and over heard the statement made by Neha to Veena.
  - He then went to inform Neha's brother Umesh who worked nearby. On the way Ravi conveyed to him the information regarding the burning of Neha and also what he had heard Neha telling Veena.
  - Umesh reached the House of Vivek at 2:00 PM with Ravi and saw a number of persons gathered there. Neha was lying on the floor of kitchen.
  - Umesh noticed that she had burned all over her body umesh went close to Neha and took her palm into her hands and inquired "Did her in law set her on fire"? Neha nodded "yes" and hardly said "you tell father and mother about this as she was dying".
- 2) Doctor P Nanda was called by Naresh for examining Neha. He gave her first aid and advised the family member to take her to PGI Chandigarh. Neha was taken to hospital where she was declared brought dead. Umesh thereupon went to the police station and launch the report. A case under section 302, 304 B read with section 34 of IPC was registered in the police station sector-11 Chandigarh. The postmortem report disclosed burn to the extent of 90% on the body of Neha and she died because of them.
- 3) Father of Neha, Raj Kumar told the investigating officer that at the time of marriage he had given rupees 1,00,000 as cash and promised to give an acre of land to her daughter which was to be registered in the name of Neha and Vivek and another acre to Umesh at his marriage. Vivek had been pressurizing Neha for registration of land in his name. The in-laws surrendered in the court of session on May 10, 2019. The matter is pending for the trial before court of sessions.

Charges/ Issue raised

Gopal Krishnan Vivek and pushpa have been charged with section 302 section 304B read with section 34 of IPC for the crime of murder, dowry death in furtherance of common intention.

## Moot Court Problem

LL.B 1<sup>st</sup> SEMESTER

The serious issue of law and order situation arose in the State of Hoshiarpur. The government of Hoshiarpur issued the order on 04.08.2021, to discontinue all mobile phone networks, internet services, landline connectivity in the Hoshiarpur, with restrictions on movement also being imposed in some areas. In light of the prevailing circumstances, on the same day, the District Magistrates, apprehending breach of peace and tranquility, imposed restrictions on movement and public gatherings by virtue of powers vested under Section 144, Cr.PC. Due to the aforesaid restrictions, the Petitioner namely Begum Sakeena claims that the movement of journalists was severely restricted and on 05.08.2021, Hoshiarpur Edition could not be distributed. The Petitioner has submitted that since 06.08.2021, she has been unable to publish the Hoshiarpur edition of the X news pursuant to the aforesaid restrictions. Aggrieved by the same, the Petitioner (Begum Sakeena) approached the Supreme Court of India under Article 32 of the Constitution seeking issuance of an appropriate writ for setting aside or quashing any and all orders, notifications, directions and circulars issued by the Respondents under which all modes of communication including internet, mobile and fixed line telecommunication services have been shut down or suspended or in any way made inaccessible or unavailable in Hoshiarpur valley. Further, the Petitioner sought the issuance of an appropriate writ or direction directing Respondents (State of Hoshiarpur) to immediately restore all modes of communication including mobile, internet and landline services throughout Hoshiarpur in order to provide an enabling environment for the media to practice its profession. Moreover, the Petitioner also pleaded to pass any appropriate writ or direction directing the Respondents to take necessary steps for ensuring free and safe movement of reporters and journalists and other media personnel. Lastly, she also pleaded for the framing of guidelines ensuring that the rights and means of media personnel to report and publish news are not unreasonably curtailed.

3. Can ~~Seema~~ Rohan be held liable under section 18 of domestic violence Act



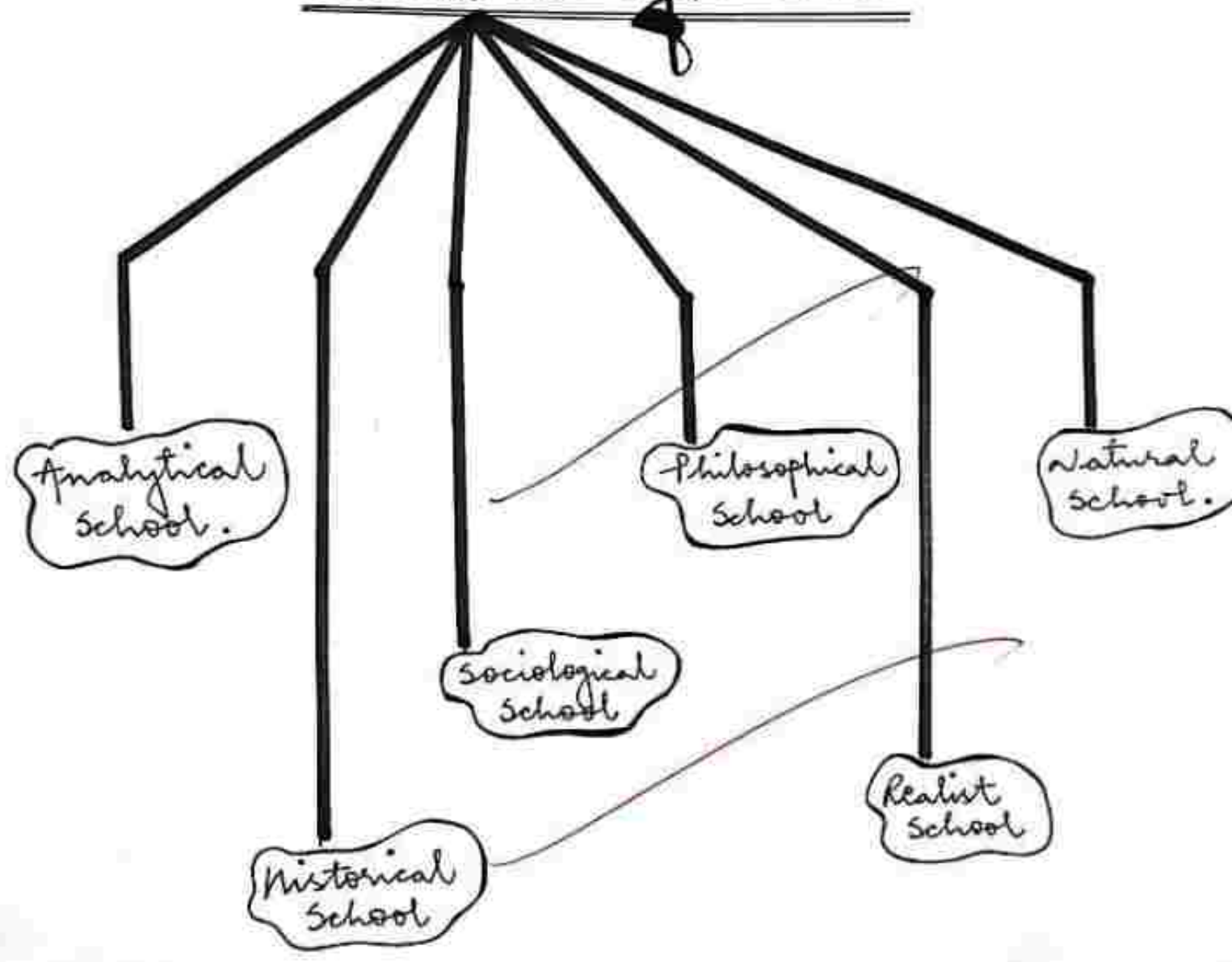
Though law and justice are intimately connected with each other, there is difference between the two. Law seeks to give justice, but law is not justice. The modern courts of law provide legal & not moral justice.

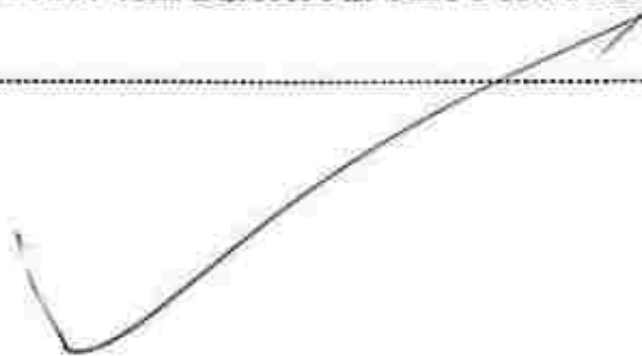

## SUMMARY OF FACTS

1. Navita is a 28 years old, married woman who works in a BPO Company Pune. She used to travel to her workplace and back by her company transport, public transport or by an auto rickshaw.
2. On 17/10/2012 i.e. the day of the incident, she was working late and missed her company transport. She accepted the offer of lift near a Mall on Nagar road by Sachin Mishra (Accused no.-1) in cab driven by him along with two others i.e. VikramJhadav (Security Guard) (Accused no.-2) and AniketSalwi (Accused no.-3). They promised to take her to her house in Katraj and therefore she placed her trust in them.
3. The brutes took her advantage as she was the only woman in the cab. They drove her across the city and raped her several times. In the meantime, T. Ramlinga (Approver) joined them and raped her as well.
4. Her dead body was found near Markal road, the next day. The post-mortem revealed that the cause of her death was strangulation by cloth, which was probably her dupatta. Her face and head was brutally crushed with heavy stones to camouflage her identity in order to destroy evidence.
5. Trial took place and all three were held guilty of gang-rape and murder and were sentenced to death u/s 376(A), 397, 302, 404, 120(B) of IPC for that horrific crime. T. Ramligam was acquitted. All the three accused filed an appeal before the Bombay High Court against the decision of the Trial Court Pune.
