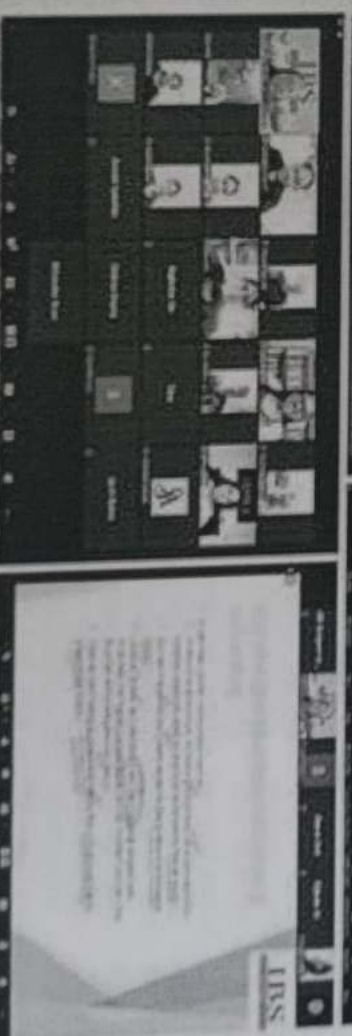




One day faculty development programme on “360 acadamician- scope and challenges” organized
