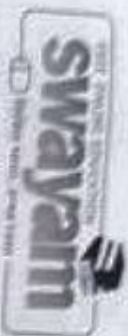

Prominent among

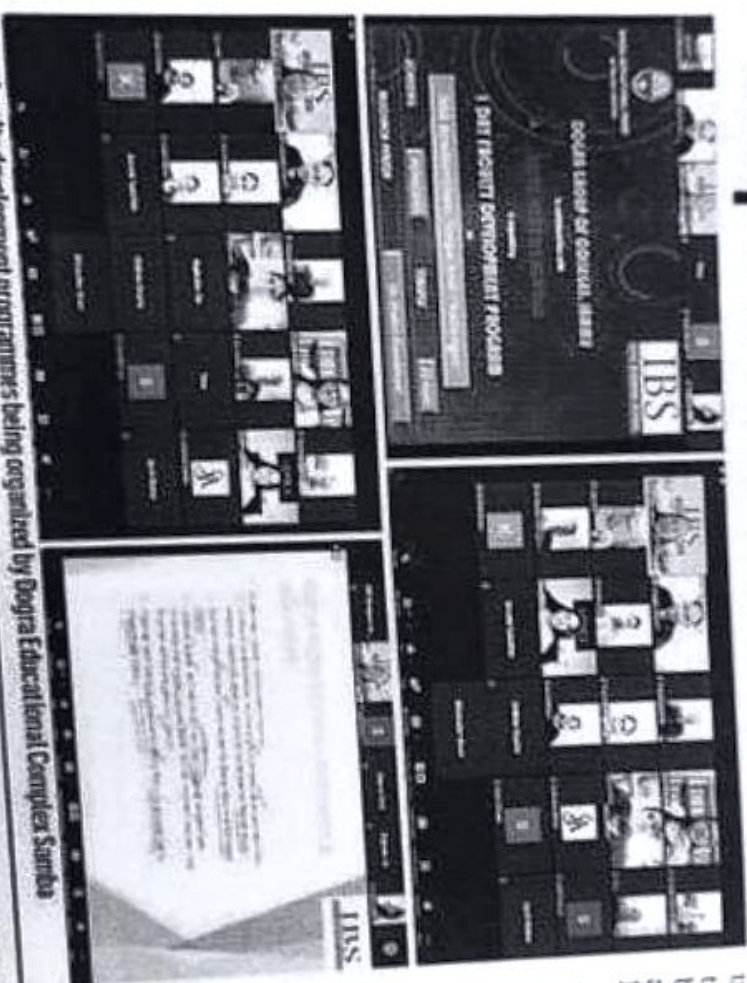
