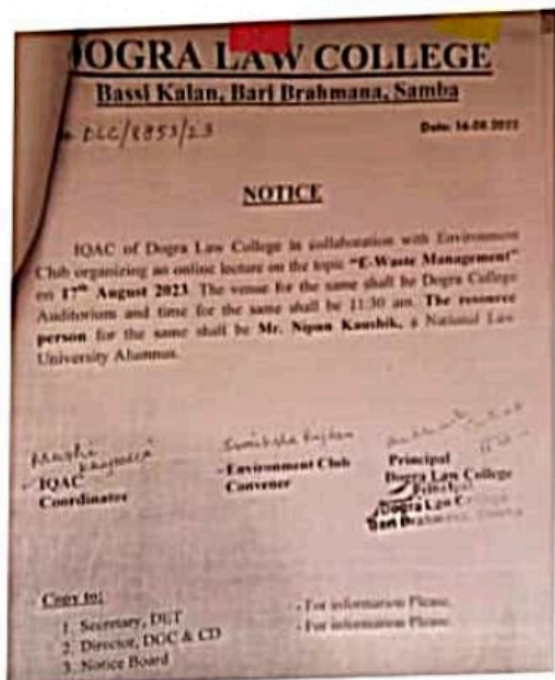

Policy Document on Waste Management

Dogra Law College understands the importance of waste Management and its effects on the environment. We are committed to minimizing waste production by employing Reduction, Re-use and Recycling techniques to ensure clean, green and safe campus. Towards this end, The College has developed a clear cut policy of waste Management and its disposal. The college also believes in sensitizing and involving the staff and students in the process of waste management and its disposal.

Objectives: -

- To protect our environment from pollution.
- To make aware the stakeholders regarding the benefits of clean, green and sustainable environment.
- To promote Reduce and Reuse of waste products.
- To ensure sustainability and effective waste management system.

Policy Implementation

The whole campus is cleaned by hired staff. The college is also involving students and staff in maintaining the campus clean, green and safe like organizing Cleanliness Drive etc. The waste generated by daily cleaning is kept in large dustbins and collected by municipal corporation vehicle on daily basis. The college encourages environment friendly practices which are as follows:

1. Solid Waste Management: -

- To reduce waste at the college the students and staff are educated on proper waste management practices through lectures, advertisements on notice boards and displaying slogan boards in the campus.
- Solid waste like glass, metals, plastics, newspapers, magazines are collected on a daily bases and disposed off from time to time with the scrap dealer.
- Dustbin has been installed at different points of college separately for solid waste.
- Different colored dustbins are installed for segregation of solid waste in the college campus.


- Cleaning and emptying of dustbins are done on regular basis every day.
- Municipality vehicles on daily basis carry the waste away
- College strictly follows the guidelines regarding no plastic usage and has prohibited the use of "single use plastic" like carry bags, plastic water bottles.

2. E-Waste Management: -

- E-Waste mainly includes obsolete and dysfunctional devices such as computer systems, servers, Monitors, Printers, Scanners, Copier etc.
- Though not much e-waste is generated in the institution on a daily basis, the electronic waste in the college includes discarded electrical or electronic devices such as used electronic parts fused electric bulbs, wires, computer peripherals broken or unusable.
- Electronic gadgets are repaired for minor defects to ensure its optimum utilization.
- The items like printer cartridges are refilled and used and the unusable items are disposed.

3. Liquid Waste Management: -

- The Institution provides provisions for the handling of liquid waste generated from the washrooms, toilets in the septic tanks located in the outermost boundary of college.
- Liquid waste generated through washing, cleaning and urination is safely disposed off in the septic tank.
- Proper sewage system is present in all the washrooms of the college, appropriate care is taken to see that there is no water stagnation to discourage mosquito breeding.
