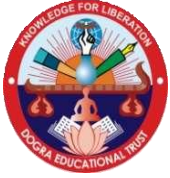
Policy Document on Energy Usage

Action Plan: -

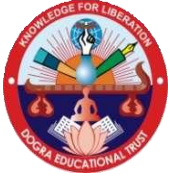
In order to achieve the above energy policy objectives the following steps will be taken
