# Feedback Report 2021-2022

Feedback from students -

Students are the integral part of every college institution, in fact colleges are meant for student's development. So our college has taken feedback from the students to know their satisfaction level also the needs and wants on curricular activity and institutional development. The students were given feedback form based on the performa containing a questionnaire about their teachers, syllabus etc. They were asked to fill in their responses. Total confidentiality was ensured to them.

We have framed 23 questions, answer to which by the students will help the college to consider their level of satisfaction and more about their need and demands. It will definitely

serve the best ultimately for the development of our college institution.

Feedback taken from the students on curricular and teaching, learning process at our dogra law college reveals the following aspects -

- Our college has taken feedback from 50 students of LLB 5 year course and 48 students of LLB 3 year course. Thus in all the total sample taken is 98 in number. Among which almost all the students has given positive feedback relating to all the 23
- Most of the students are satisfied with that the subjects included in the syllabus are supportive to stand them as a lawyer in the court.

Feedback on suggestive questions

- 1. In suggestive answers to the questions the students have suggested for frequency of issue
- 2. They have also given suggestion like college to arrange Supreme Court and High court visits and to promote internships and field visit opportunity.
- 3. Some have suggested for taking activity based assignment submission.
