Under the ongoing "Puneet Sagar Abhiyan" NCC Unit of Dogra Degree College and Dogra Law College on behalf of 4 J&K NCC Battalion conducted phase II of river cleaning drive in the Tawi River along the Hari Ki Pauri Stretch. As we know that Hari Ki Pauri is a prominent tourist place in Jammu city and is abuzz with religious festivities specially during the Navratras. Around 40 NCC Cadets took the initiative of cleaning the holy river Suryaputri (Tawi) by collecting the dumped waste. The waste mainly comprised of single use plastic waste, cloths, flowers & old household items from the river and disposed-off the collected waste alongside the Temple complex under the guidance of Mr. Rishabh Bakshi CTO NCC, Dogra Degree College and Mr. Desh Bandu, CTO NCC, Dogra Law College. Along with the cleanliness drive, the volunteers also tried to create awareness amongst the people. "We reiterated to the people the importance of segregating the garbage before throwing it away. regular hand washing, sanitizing and following coughing and sneezing etiquettes.


